

Project Proposal

Objective: Create a plan for using your planter box to make a positive impact on your community. Present your plan in a way that will engage your classmates.

Phase 1 Māla: Choose a plant that you will use to accomplish the objective. When deciding on your plant, consider the following:

(Garden)

- Cost
 - Where will they be purchased from? (groups are encouraged to find local providers if possible)
- Amount of time it takes from planting to harvest (recommendation: 3 weeks_±)
 - Planting from seedling or seed?
- Planting
 - How will you maximize the amount of space in your planter box(es)
- Uses for the plant
 - What can be cooked with it?
 - What is the cost of ingredients for this recipe?

Phase 2 Create a presentation to showcase your plan to your classmates. You may use the format of your choice (PowerPoint, video, speech, etc). Your presentation should include the following:

- Plant Background
- Plan for planting / harvesting
- Recipe
- Community Engagement Strategy: This will be an opportunity for you to showcase your plans and how they came to fruition, the recipes you developed, and the positive impact you hope to make on their community. This could be an event on campus or partnership with a community center.

Your presentation should also address factors such as cost, safety, reliability, aesthetics, and social, environmental, cultural impacts for each of the components listed above.

After your presentation, you will be scored by your classmates. The group with the highest score will have their plan implemented.
